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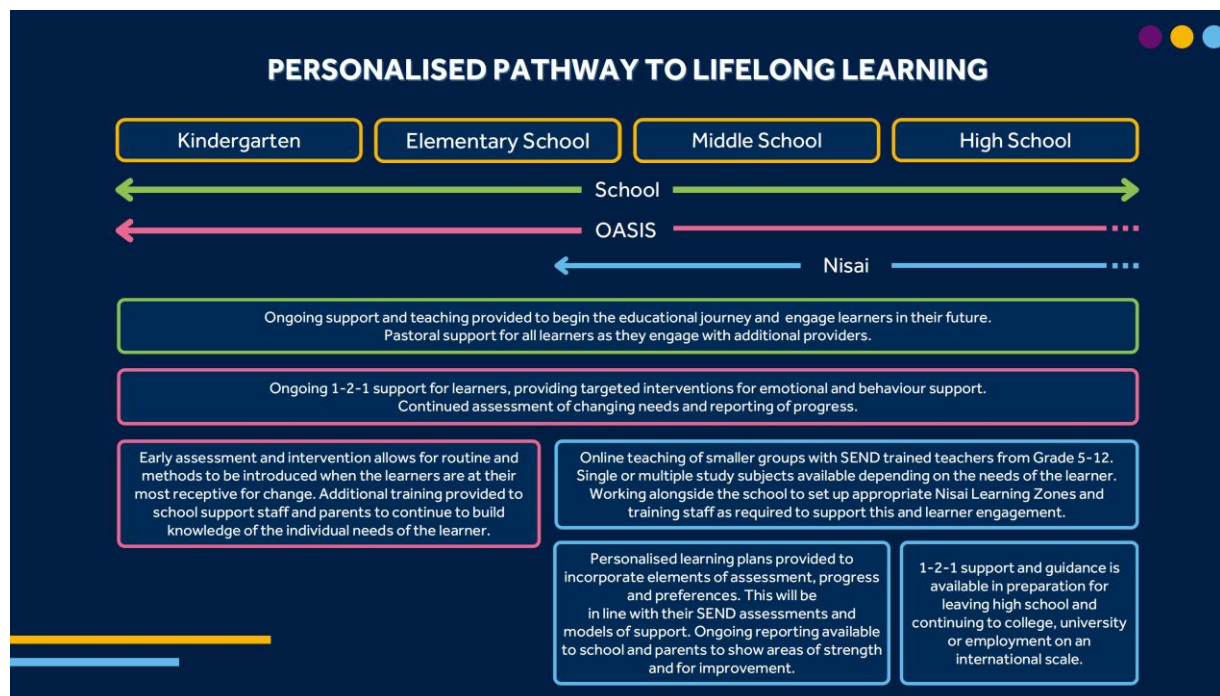


Image 5 - Personalised pathway to lifelong learning with Nisai and Oasis Place

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
